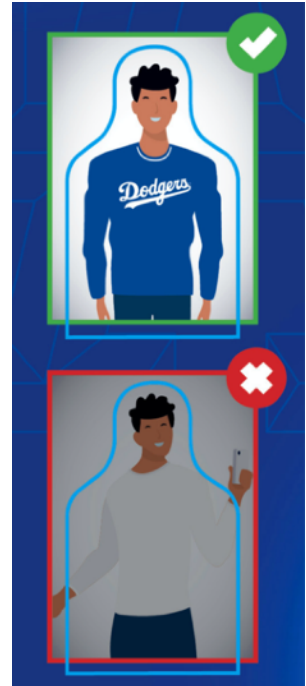

How to take the perfect photo:

1. New photos work best, so pick a space and get ready to smile! Feel free to use your smartphone, but no selfies please.
2. Find a space with good lighting and try to have a solid, one color background. Make sure your shirt color and the background are contrasting colors.
3. Have a friend or family member take the photo for you standing 3-4 feet directly in front of you and hold the phone vertically.
4. You can have your hands at your side or place them in a gassho position, just remember to keep your hands and arms within your body width.
5. Make sure to face the camera and capture at least your waist up.
6. Put on your best smile as we all recite the Nembutsu "together!"



Furry family member photos:



1. Make sure you are eye level with your pet. The photo must be of just your pet.
2. Have your pet sit versus laying down. Try to have them face the camera.
3. Find a space with good lighting. Make sure your background is not a similar color to your pet.
4. Please be sure to remove any visible personal identification you don't want the public to see such as a name or phone number that might appear on collar/tags.
5. Have your pet give us a big smile as the WLA Buddhist Temple welcomes them to Sunday service for the first time!
